This country was Spain, a country with rich history, beautiful cities, and kind and friendly people. Many immigrants of CIS moved to this country in search of a better life and jobs. A country with relatively low cost of living became a place where a lot of brothers and sisters permanently moved.

Sadly, Spain did not become a center of missionary work of Slavic Christian unions for the establishment of churches (with the exception of the Pentecostal churches). God moved the hearts of the Association's leadership to begin ministering there.

I.V. Mileyev, the leader of missionary department of PCSBA, and a few other people visited Spain in order to familiarize themselves with the situation and to meet with the President of the Union of Evangelical Baptists of Spain.
