After going through intense suffering and despair, she did not become distant in her trial, but rose up a huge following around the world to serve and help people with a handicap. Thanks to her intercession, many laws were changed, and new versions of the laws passed with a goal of improving the lives of people traumatized by both chronic, as well as developed handicaps.


