She replied, "The absolute weight doesn't matter. It depends on how long I hold it. If I hold it for a minute, it's not a problem. If I hold it for an hour, I'll have an ache in my arm. If I hold it for a day, my arm will feel numb and paralyzed. In each case, the weight of the glass doesn't change, but the longer I hold it, the heavier it becomes."

#### She continued:

"The stresses and worries in life are like that glass of water. Think about them for a while and nothing happens. Think about them a bit longer and they begin to hurt. And if you think about them all day long, you will feel paralyzed - incapable of doing anything."

It's important to remember to let go of your stresses. As early ... as you can, put all your burdens down. Don't carry them through the evening and into the night. Remember to put the glass down!

"Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls" (Matthew 11:28-29, ESV).

#### **SUMMIT IN DEFENSE OF PERSECUTED CHRISTIANS**

On May 10-13, there was an international Summit in Defense of Persecuted Christians in Washington D.C. The summit organizer was Franklin Graham who is a leader of the "The Samaritan's Bag" missionary group and a son of a well-known preacher—Billy Graham. More than 600 Christian leaders from 130 countries were invited to the summit with a goal of discussing the state of the persecuted Christians around the world.

Those who attended the summit were shocked by the personal testimonies of the relatives of Christians who were martyred by the ISIS, as well as testimonies of those who were tortured for their faith, had lost their loved ones, were raped, and were beaten.
