1. SPIRITUAL STRENGTHENING OF PASTORS

“Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.” (2 Tim. 2:15)

Spiritual level of pastors affects the spiritual health of the church. Our Association has to provide means for pastoral growth, and create an atmosphere where each pastor can find the encouragement, support, and be strengthened in the Lord.

2. UNITY AND SUPPORT AMONG CHURCHES AND MINISTERS.

The future of the church depends on how well we are ready to share our experience, faith, and to minister to the young generation. Our goal is not just to keep the youth in our churches, but to entrust the ministry to them. Young leaders need to feel that they are a full-fledged part of the church family.

5. JOINT VISION AND STRATEGY

WORKING TOGETHER WITH PASTORS AND CHURCHES

- Local churches are the foundation and purpose of the Association's existence
- Pastors are spiritual leaders who affect the spiritual growth of the churches and the congregations.

Our goal is to strengthen connections between pastors, help churches be spiritually healthy, and facilitate joint ministry.

SPIRITUAL WORK WITH PASTORS

- Regular visits, consultations, assistance with resources and spiritual support.
- Involving smaller churches in the projects of the Association so that no church feels isolated.
- Strengthening relationships between pastors, especially those from small and remote churches.

- Conducting local evangelistic services and events.
- Contributing to service projects outside your community.
- Mentoring young pastors and youth leaders.
- Involving youth in decision-making and community service.

SPIRITUAL SUPPORT OF PASTORS



- Regular personal meetings with pastors of local churches.
- Individual conversations, prayers, mentoring.
- Discussing community problems and seeking solutions together.

- Online groups for pastors to share experiences and resources.
- Joint calls and video conferences to resolve difficult issues.
- Annual meetings of ministers of all the PCSBA churches.
- Joint prayer and celebratory services.

- Organizing annual spiritual retreats for pastors and leaders.
- Seminars on leadership, spiritual discipline, and balancing church life



DEVELOPMENT OF PCSBA DEPARTMENTS' MINISTRIES

The Association's departments are the means through which the Association serves the churches. They enable each church to participate in the overall mission, develop ministries, and model the faith to the next generation.

The development of these departments strengthens the churches and makes the Association more effective.

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND DISCIPLINE

Purpose: To prepare new leaders for churches and departments.

Practical steps:

- Conducting seminars and training for all ministers.
- Mentoring young leaders and future ministers.
- Training of future teachers

MISSIONS MINISTRY

Purpose: To spread the Gospel and support missionaries.

Practical steps:

- Support for internal and external missionary projects.
- Promoting Prison Ministry
- Developing partnerships with missionary organizations.
- Conducting missionary training

YOUTH MINISTRY

Purpose: To involve the younger generation in the life of the Association and to prepare future leaders.

Practical steps:

- Conducting camps, retreats and conferences.
- Preparing youth for leadership in future ministries.
- Mentoring young leaders and involving them in decision making.

MUSIC MINISTRY

Purpose: To coordinate and support the music ministries of the PCSBA churches by growing the worship ministry, training worship leaders, and strengthening spiritual unity through music.

Practical steps:

- Organization of joint musical events and conferences of the Association.
- Support and training for choir, orchestra and worship team leaders.
- Promoting a biblical understanding of worship and spiritual service through music.

WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Purpose: To provide women with support in spiritual growth and equip them to be able to serve others.

Practical steps:

- Organizing conferences, seminars and prayer meetings for women.
- Support for mothers, widows, and women who are actively involved in the life of the church.

CHILDREN'S AND TEENS' MINISTRY

Purpose: To provide education to a new generation in faith and love for Christ.

Practical steps:

- Training of Sunday School teachers and youth group leaders
- Providing various means of assistance to families who have children with special needs
- Organization of children's camps

INFORMATION AND MEDIA MINISTRY

Purpose: To strengthen the unity and awareness of churches through modern means of communication while encouraging them to get involved in ministry and Gospel proclamation.

Practical steps:

- Coordination of publications, reports, videos, podcasts, website operations, newsletters, and photographs to promote the Association's ministries.
- Active presence of the Association on social networks and YouTube.

ADMINISTRATIVE MINISTRY

Purpose: To ensure financial sustainability, effective management of resources and administrative support for all ministries of the Association.

Practical steps:

- Efficient operation of the Association's office and coordination of administrative processes.
- Ensuring the financial stability of the Association and provide transparent reporting.
- Property management and leasing
- Development and support of the PCSBA Thrift Store
